### **Microsoft Teams**

Teachers will upload home learning assignments on to their class team and will respond to work submitted by children. Children can complete assigned activities on their Team, uploading photographs, text, drawings and videos to demonstrate understanding. In the event of children having to self-isolate from school, activities across the range of curriculum subjects will be posted daily. This will include:

- A daily Literacy Lesson
- A daily Maths Lesson
- A daily phonics/spelling activity
- An additional daily lesson e.g. Science, History, Geography, Art, PE, DT etc. (the whole range of curriculum subjects to be covered across the isolation period in line with the class timetable)

Assignments may be set for the whole class or differentiated to meet the needs of different learners. Children's responses to these assignments/activities will be acknowledged and recorded by a member of staff and are used to inform assessments and future assignments.
