<p><i>Environment</i> Woods Trees Path Street Houses Shops Parks Hills</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are looking at and comparing woodland environments to our own environment and recognising why they are different.
<p><i>Nocturnal Animals</i> Bat Cat Owl Fox Hedgehog Moth Badger</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are finding out which animals are nocturnal.
<p><i>Light and dark</i> Day and night</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are learning the differences between day and night. We are exploring light and dark using shadow puppets.
<p><i>Traditional Tales</i> Billy Goats gruff Little Rd Riding Hood</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are learning to keep ourselves safe. We are learning to collaboratively build structures. We are learning to compare characters from stories.
