

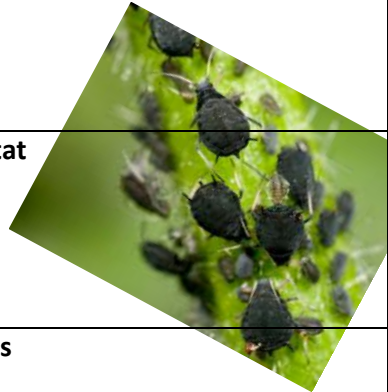
Knowledge Organiser - Ugly Bug Ball!

Key Terms

Habitat	<p>A habitat is where something lives, a natural environment. For example; wetlands, grasslands and woodlands.</p>
Microhabitat	<p>A microhabitat will differ from the larger environment around it, making it particularly suited to one or more species, for example the damp underside of a stone.</p>
Food chains	<p>A food chain shows how each living thing gets food and how nutrients and energy are passed from creature to creature.</p>
Antennae	<p>Insects have two antennae and these are used to sense their environment.</p>
Life Cycle	<p>A life cycle is the different stages of life for a living thing.</p>



There are over 25,000 mini beast species in Britain.

The scientific term for mini beasts is 'invertebrates' - a creature without a backbone.
