Key Terms

Seaside	A seaside resort is a resort town or resort village, or resort hotel, located on the coast.
Beach	An area of sand or small stones near the sea or another area of water such as a lake.
Sand dunes	A sand dune is a mound, hill or ridge of sand that lies behind the part of the beach affected by tides.
Cliff	A cliff is a vertical, or nearly vertical, rock exposure.
Tide	Tides are the rise and fall of sea levels.
Promenade	A paved public walk, typically along the seafront at a resort.
Bathing machine	The bathing machine was a device, popular from the 18th century until the early 20th century, to allow people to change out of their usual clothes, change into swimwear, and wade in the ocean at beaches.
